Get Out the Vote in Arizona



The voter registration deadline in Arizona, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 7.

ID Requirements

In Arizona, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. Two valid forms of ID without a photo can fulfill the voter ID requirement.

Absentee Voting

Arizona does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 25.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Arizona can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins in Arizona on Wednesday, October 9 and ends on Friday, November 1.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Arizona at 6 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
