Get Out the Vote in Arkansas



The voter registration deadline in Arkansas, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 7.

ID Requirements

In Arkansas, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. Voters who do not have a photo ID may cast a provisional ballot.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Arkansas need a valid excuse to vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 29 (online or by mail) or Friday, November 1 (in-person)

Absentee ballots must be received by Friday, November 1, if dropping off inperson, and by 7:30 pm on Tuesday, November 5 if returning by mail.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Arkansas can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, October 21 and ends on Monday, November 4.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Arkansas at 7:30 am and close at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
