Get Out the Vote in Connecticut



The voter registration deadline in Connecticut, for the November 2024 election, is Friday, October 18.

ID Requirements

In Connecticut, identification to cast a ballot is required for first time voters who registered by mail. If they do not have identification, they may cast a provisional ballot.

All other voters (most voters) must provide a social security card or any printed form of identification that shows your name and address or name and signature. Instead of identification, you may also sign a statement under penalty of perjury that you are the same person that appears on the official election checklist.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Connecticut with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Monday, November 4.

Absentee ballots must be received by Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered to your local election office or a drop box on election day.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Connecticut can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins in Connecticut on Monday, October 21 and ends on Sunday, November 3.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Connecticut at 6 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
