The voter registration deadline in Georgia, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 7.

ID Requirements

In Georgia, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. More information can be found here: sos.ga.gov/page/georgia-voter-identification-requirements

Absentee Voting

Georgia does not require an excuse for absentee voting. Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 25.

Absentee ballots must be received by Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Georgia can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Tuesday, October 15 and ends on Friday, November 1. Hours and the availability of Sunday voting differ by county.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Georgia at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
