

# Get Out the Vote in Hawai'i



**The voter registration deadline in Hawai'i, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 28.**



## **ID Requirements**

In Hawai'i, photo ID is not required to register and cast a ballot. Voters must provide some form of identification (e.g. social security number, utility bill, paycheck) when registering to vote.

## **Absentee Voting**

All registered voters will automatically receive a mail ballot on approximately Friday, October 18. You only need to request an absentee ballot if you need it mailed to a temporary mailing address.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot can be returned in person at a voter service center or drop box. You can find locations here: [elections.hawaii.gov/voter-service-centers-and-places-of-deposit/](https://elections.hawaii.gov/voter-service-centers-and-places-of-deposit/)

**If you are in line to vote on election day  
when the polls close - STAY IN LINE.  
You must be allowed to cast your ballot.**

## Early Voting

All registered voters in Hawai'i can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Tuesday, October 22 and ends on Monday, November 4.

## Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Hawai'i at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
