Get Out the Vote in Idaho



The voter registration deadline in Idaho, for the November 2024 election, is Friday, October 11.

ID Requirements

In Idaho, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) and proof of residence are required to register to vote. Photo ID is requested while checking in to vote, but is not required. Voters who do not have a photo ID may sign an affidavit attesting to their identity and cast a regular ballot.

Absentee Voting

Idaho does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 25 (by mail or online) or Friday, November 1 (in-person).

Absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to a polling place on election day. You must return it by mail or at a secure ballot drop box.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE.
You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

The availability of early voting depends on the county. Check with your county elections office for early voting availability, dates, and times: voteidaho.gov/county-clerk/

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Idaho at 8 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

You can register to vote on election day at your polling place.
