# Get Out the Vote in Indiana



The voter registration deadline in Indiana, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 7.

### **ID** Requirements

In Indiana, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. Voters who do not have a photo ID may cast a provisional ballot. Voters who complete a provisional ballot have until noon 10 days after the election to provide the necessary documentation for their vote to be counted.

## **Absentee Voting**

Voters in Indiana with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Thursday, October 24.

Absentee ballot applications must include the voter's voter ID number or a photocopy of their ID.

Absentee ballots must be received by 6 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

# **In-Person Absentee Voting**

All registered voters in Indiana can vote in-person absentee (early voting) for any reason. In-person absentee voting begins on Tuesday, October 8 and ends at 12 pm on Monday, November 4.

# **Voting on Election Day**

Polls open in Indiana at 6 am and close at 6 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
