Get Out the Vote in Iowa



The voter registration deadline in Iowa, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 21.

ID Requirements

In Iowa, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. Any registered voter who does not have a valid driver's license or non-operator ID will be automatically issued a Voter ID Card for free.

Absentee Voting

lowa does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Monday, October 21.

Absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail or in person to your county auditor.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Iowa can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Wednesday October 16 and ends on Tuesday, November 4.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Iowa at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

You can register to vote at your polling place on election day.
