Get Out the Vote in Kentucky



The voter registration deadline in Kentucky, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 7.

ID Requirements

In Kentucky, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot. Voters who do not have a photo ID may cast a provisional ballot. For your provisional ballot to count, you must present a valid ID to your county clerk's office.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Kentucky with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 22.

Absentee ballots must be received by 6 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot by delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it by mail, using a drop box, or at a local election office.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

Any registered voter who has not requested a mail-in ballot and who has a valid excuse can vote early in person from Wednesday, October 23 - Saturday, November 2. Unexcused early voting takes place from Thursday, October 31 -Saturday, November 2.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Kentucky at 6 am and close at 6 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
