

Get Out the Vote in Maine



The voter registration deadline in Maine, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.



ID Requirements

In Maine, photo ID is not required to register and cast a ballot. If you register to vote on election day, you must show ID and proof of residence. If you do not have ID or proof of residence, you can cast a challenged ballot. You will be asked to show ID after the election.

Absentee Voting

Maine does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Thursday, October 31.

Absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return them by mail, drop box, or in person at your municipal office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Maine can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Sunday, October 6 and ends on Thursday, October 31. Early voting may be available in some municipalities before Sunday, October 6.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Maine between 6 am and 10 am, depending on the population of the town, and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

You can register to vote at your town or city hall on election day.
