Get Out the Vote in Maryland



The voter registration deadline in Maryland, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.

ID Requirements

In Maryland, photo ID is not required to register or cast a ballot. Some voters may need to provide identification to cast a ballot if they registered by mail without providing identification.

Mail-In Voting

Maryland does not require an excuse for mail-in voting. Voters must request their mail-in ballot by Tuesday, October 29 if requesting by mail; Friday, November 1 if requesting online; and Tuesday, November 5 if requesting in person.

Mail-in ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5, and received by 10 am on Friday, November 15, if returning by mail. Ballots must be received by Tuesday, November 5 if returning in person.

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered, before 8 pm, on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE.
You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Maryland can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Thursday, October 24 and ends on Thursday, October 31.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Maryland at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
