# Get Out the Vote in Massachusetts



The voter registration deadline in Massachusetts, for the November 2024 election, is Saturday, October 26.

### **ID** Requirements

In Massachusetts, identification may be required to register and cast a ballot. You may need to show identification before voting if you're voting for the first time, if you're on the inactive voter list, or if the poll worker has a "practical and legal reason" to ask.

### **Absentee Voting**

All registered voters are eligible for no-excuse voting by mail. Voters will receive a postcard application for their mail ballot in September.

If you need your ballot sent to a temporary mailing address, you must submit an absentee ballot application.

Mail and absentee ballots must be requested by Tuesday, October 29.

Mail and absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on November 5.

You cannot drop your ballot off at a polling place on election day. You must mail it back, hand deliver it to your local election office, or use a ballot drop box.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

## **Early Voting**

All registered voters in Massachusetts can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Saturday, October 19 and ends on Friday, November 1.

# **Voting on Election Day**

Polls open in Massachusetts at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
