Get Out the Vote in Nebraska



The voter registration deadline in Nebraska, for the November 2024 election, is Friday, October 18 (postmarked and online) and Friday, October 25 (received by mail and in-person).

ID Requirements

In Nebraska, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. If you do not have a state ID, you may obtain a free voter ID from the Nebraska DMV.

Absentee Voting

Nebraska does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 25.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm MT/ 8 pm CT on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. It must be mailed, placed in a drop box, or returned to the county election official's office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Nebraska can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, October 7 and ends on Monday, November 4.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Nebraska at 7 am MT/ 8 am CT and close at 7 pm MT/ 8 pm CT on Tuesday, November 5.
