Get Out the Vote in New Hampshire



The voter registration deadline in New Hampshire, for the November 2024 election, depends on the locality.



ID Requirements

In New Hampshire, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID) is required to register and cast a ballot. If you do not have an approved ID, you can obtain a free photo ID by presenting a voucher from your town clerk to any NH DMV.

Absentee Voting

Voters in New Hampshire with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 29 if requesting by mail. Voters can request a ballot in person until 3 pm on Monday, November 4.

Absentee ballots must be received by 5 pm on Tuesday, November 5 if returning by mail. If returning in person, ballots must be received by 5 pm on Monday, November 4.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.
