Get Out the Vote in New Jersey



The voter registration deadline in New Jersey, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.

ID Requirements

In New Jersey, ID is not required to cast a ballot, unless you did not provide identification when registering. When you register, you'll be asked to provide a driver's license number, non-driver ID number, or the last four digits of your social security number.

Vote-by-Mail

New Jersey does not require an excuse to vote by mail.

Voters must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 29 if requesting by mail. In person requests must be received by 3 pm on Monday, November 4.

Vote-By-Mail ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5 if returning in person. If returning by mail, it must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5 and received by Monday, November 11.

Your Vote-By-Mail ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail, drop box, or hand deliver to your county's Board of Elections office.

Early Voting

All registered voters in New Jersey can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Saturday, October 26 and ends on Sunday, November 3.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in New Jersey at 6 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
