Get Out the Vote in Pennsylvania



The voter registration deadline in Pennsylvania, for the November 2024 election, is Mondady, October 21.

ID Requirements

In Pennsylvania, identification is not required to cast a ballot unless it is your first time voting at a polling place. If you do not have photo ID, you can use another ID that includes your name and address, including a current utility bill or bank statement.

Absentee Voting

Pennsylvania does not require an excuse to vote by mail.

The deadline to request a mail-in or absentee ballot is 5 pm on Tuesday, October 29.

Absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

All voters, except those with disabilities, must return their own ballot. Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail, at a drop box, or at your county election office.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Pennsylvania can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, September 16 and ends on Tuesday, October 29.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Pennsylvania at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
