

Get Out the Vote in South Dakota



The voter registration deadline in South Dakota, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 21.



ID Requirements

In South Dakota, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is requested to cast a ballot. If a voter does not have a photo ID, they can sign a personal identification affidavit and vote a regular ballot.

Absentee Voting

South Dakota does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Monday, November 4.

Absentee ballots must be received by your County Election Official on Tuesday, November 5 with “enough time to deliver your ballot to your voting precinct before the polls close.”

Drop boxes have been outlawed in South Dakota.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day.

Early Voting

All registered voters in South Dakota can vote early at the county auditor's office for any reason. Early voting begins on Friday, September 20 and ends on Monday, November 4.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in South Dakota at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
