# Get Out the Vote in the U.S. Virgin Islands



The voter registration deadline in the U.S. Virgin Islands, for the November 2024 election, is Sunday, October 6.

## **ID** Requirements

In the U.S. Virgin Islands, identification is required to register and is requested when casting a ballot. If a voter does not have proper identification, they can complete an affidavit of affirmation that they are the person listed on the poll list before being permitted to vote.

### **Absentee Voting**

The U.S. Virgin Islands do not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Most voters must request their ballot by Monday, October 14. Military voters can request their ballots up to Tuesday, November 5.

Absentee ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5 and received by Friday, November 15.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

## **Early Voting**

All registered voters in the Virgin Islands can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, October 14 and ends on Monday, October 28 (St. Croix and St. Thomas). Early voting begins on Monday, October 21 and events on Monday, October 28 (St. John).

## **Voting on Election Day**

Polls open in the Virgin Islands at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
