The voter registration deadline in Vermont, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, November 5.

ID Requirements

In Vermont, photo ID is not required to register and cast a ballot. However, if you're a first time voter who registered by mail, you will have to show identification in order to vote.

Absentee Voting

Vermont automatically mails ballots to all registered voters.

Voters may request an absentee ballot if they need their ballot mailed to a temporary mailing address.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered to your polling place on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Vermont can vote early for any reason. You can vote early by completing your mail ballot at your town clerk's office beginning Saturday, September 21 and ending Monday, November 4. .

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Vermont between 5 am and 10 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
