Get Out the Vote in Virginia



The voter registration deadline in Virginia, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.

ID Requirements

In Virginia, identification is requested to cast a ballot. If you do not present acceptable identification, you may sign an affidavit stating you are the voter listed. If you do not sign an affidavit, you can vote a provisional ballot.

Absentee Voting

Virginia does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 25.

Absentee ballots must be received Tuesday, November 5 if dropping it off in person. If returning by mail, the ballot must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5 and received by 12 pm on Friday, November 8.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail, at a drop box, or hand delivered to your local general registrar's office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Virginia can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Friday, September 20 and ends on Saturday, November 2.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Virginia at 6 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
