# Get Out the Vote in Washington, D.C.!

The voter registration deadline in Washington, D.C., for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.

#### **ID** Requirements

In Washington, D.C., identification is required for some first-time voters who submitted their voter registration application without identification.

Identification is not required for most voters.

### **Absentee Voting**

All voters registered before Thursday, October 31 will be automatically mailed a ballot with prepaid postage. If you need your ballot mailed to a temporary address, you must submit an absentee ballot request before Thursday, October 31.

Absentee ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5 and received no later than Friday, November 15 if returning by mail. Ballots must be received by Tuesday, November 5 if returning in-person.

## Get Out the Vote in Washington, D.C.!



If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close – STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

### **Early Voting**

All registered voters in Washington, D.C. can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins in Washington, D.C. on Monday, October 28 and ends on Sunday, November 3.

### **Voting on Election Day**

Polls open in Washington, D.C. at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
