

# Get Out the Vote in West Virginia



**The voter registration deadline in West Virginia, for the November 2024 election, is Tuesday, October 15.**



## **ID Requirements**

In West Virginia, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot in person. You are exempt from providing ID if an adult who has known you for more than 6 months vouches for you, a poll worker knows you, or you are a resident of a state care facility.

## **Absentee Voting**

West Virginia requires an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Wednesday, October 30.

Absentee ballots must be received by Monday, November 4 if returning in person. If returning via mail, it must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 5 and received by Tuesday, November 12.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail or in-person at your county clerk's office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

All registered voters in West Virginia can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Wednesday, October 23 and ends on Saturday, November 2.

## Voting on Election Day

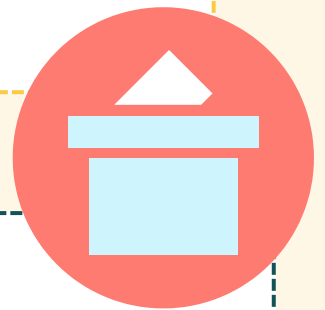
Polls open in West Virginia at 6:30 am and close at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
