Get Out the Vote in Wyoming



The voter registration deadline in Wyoming, for the November 2024 election, is Monday, October 21.

ID Requirements

In Wyoming, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot in person. If you do not have an acceptable photo ID, you can get a free WY identification card from your local Driver Services office.

Absentee Voting

Wyoming does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Monday, November 4.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail or hand delivery to your county clerk's office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Wyoming can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Tuesday, October 8 and ends on Monday, November 4.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Wyoming at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
