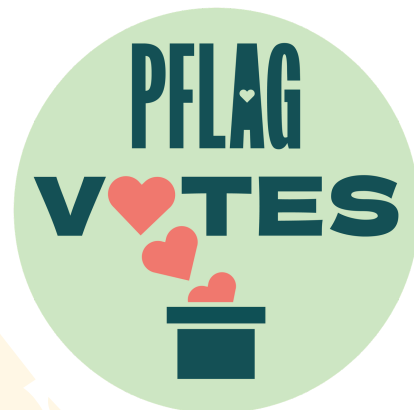


Get Out the Vote in Arkansas



The voter registration deadline in Arkansas, for the November 2026 election, is Monday, October 5.



ID Requirements

In Arkansas, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot. Voters who do not have a valid photo ID are allowed to cast a provisional ballot. They must provide a valid ID at a later date for their ballot to be counted.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Arkansas with a valid excuse can vote absentee.

Voters must request their absentee ballot by October 27 (by mail) or by close of business on October 30 (in-person)

Absentee ballots must be received by October 30 if you are returning it in person. They must be received by 7:30pm on November 3 if you are returning by mail.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand-delivered to your polling place during the early voting period or on election day.

You must be allowed to cast your ballot.**

Early Voting

All registered voters in Arkansas can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, October 19 and ends on Monday, November 2.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Arkansas at 7:30 am and close at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
