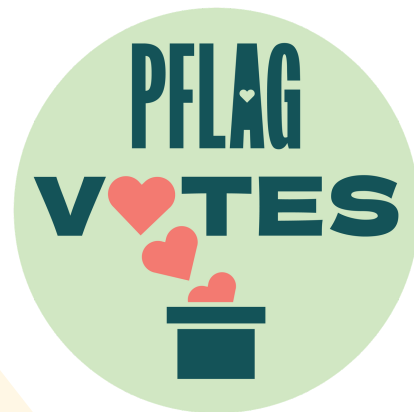




Get Out the Vote in Delaware



The voter registration deadline in Delaware, for the November 2026 election, is Saturday, October 10.



ID Requirements

In Delaware, identification is required to register and requested to cast a ballot. Voters who are unable to provide valid proof of identity may complete an Affidavit of Voter Identity. They will then be permitted to vote.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Delaware with a valid excuse may vote absentee. They must request their ballot by October 30 (mail and online) and by 12 pm ET on November 2 (in-person).

Absentee ballots must be received by 8pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered on election day to a local election office or a drop box. You cannot turn it in at your polling place during early voting or on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

Early Voting

Early voting in Delaware is open October 22-24 and October 26-27 (7am-7pm) and October 29-November 1 (11am-7pm). There is no early voting on Sunday, October 25.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Delaware at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
