

Get Out the Vote in Florida



**The voter registration deadline in Florida,
for the November 2026 election,
is Monday, October 5.**



ID Requirements

In Florida, photo ID with a signature (e.g., driver license, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. Voters who do not have a photo ID with a signature may cast a provisional ballot. The ID requirements outlined in Florida's SAVE Act, do not come into effect until January 1, 2027.

Absentee Voting

Florida does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Thursday, October 22.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

Your ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day, but it can be returned at a local election office on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Florida can vote early for any reason. Early voting is available from at least Saturday, October 24 - Saturday, October 31. Additional dates and hours may be offered in your county.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Florida at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
