is Monday, October 5.**

ID Requirements

In Georgia, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to register and cast a ballot. More information can be found here:

Absentee Voting

Georgia does not require an excuse for absentee voting. Voters must request their ballot by Friday, October 23.

Absentee ballots must be received by Tuesday, November 5.

You can request an absentee ballot here: georgia.gov/vote-absentee-ballot

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered to a county registrar's office or a drop box location. Every county is required to have a minimum of one drop box (located indoors and available to voters during operating hours).

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Georgia can vote early for any reason. •Early voting begins in Georgia on October 13 and ends on October 30. Early voting takes place Monday-Friday as well as Saturday, October 17 and October 24. The hours and the availability of Sunday voting differ by county.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Georgia at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

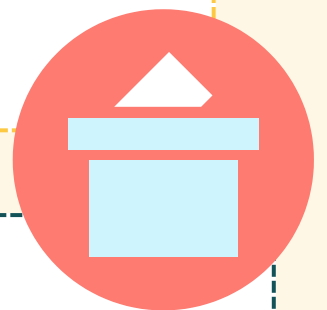
