

Get Out the Vote in Kentucky



**The voter registration deadline in Kentucky,
for the November 2026 election,
is Monday, October 5.**



ID Requirements

In Kentucky, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot. If you do not have acceptable photo-ID, you may be able to sign a “voter affirmation form” and provide an alternative such as your social security card or an EBT/food stamps/SNAP card issued by the state of Kentucky.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Kentucky with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 20.

Absentee ballots must be received by 6 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

Your absentee ballot cannot be delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it by mail, using a drop box, or at a local election office.

Early Voting

Any registered voter who has not requested a mail-in ballot and who has a valid excuse can vote early in person from Wednesday, October 21 - Saturday, October 31. Unexcused early voting takes place from Thursday, October 29 - Saturday, October 31.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Kentucky at 6 am and close at 6 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

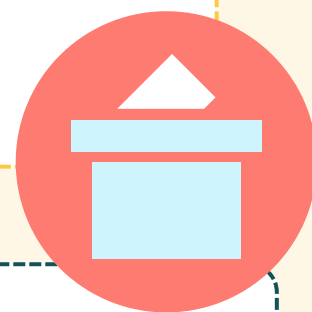
