

Get Out the Vote in Louisiana



The voter registration deadline in Louisiana, for the November 2026 election, is Monday, October 5 (by mail or in-person) and Tuesday, October 13 (online).



ID Requirements

In Louisiana, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is requested, but not required, to cast a ballot. Presenting a photo ID will make your voting experience faster and easier. If you do not present a photo ID, you can provide two primary and secondary documents that can be used to verify your identity or you can vote by signing a Voter Identification Affidavit.

Absentee Voting

Voters in Louisiana with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by 4:30 pm CST on Friday, October 30.

Absentee ballots must be received by 4:30 pm CST on Monday, November 2.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered on election day. Before November 2, it can be dropped off at the Registrars of Voters office, but only by the voter or an immediate family member.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Louisiana can vote early for any reason. •Early voting begins in Louisiana on October 20 and ends on October 27 (8:30am-6:00pm) excluding Sunday, October 25.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Louisiana at 6 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

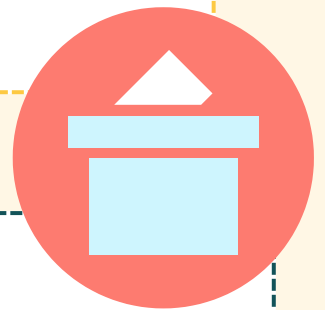
