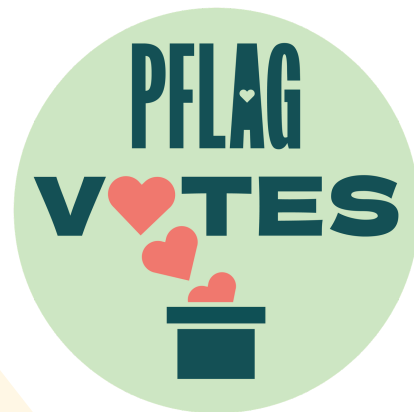


Get Out the Vote in Minnesota



**The voter registration deadline in Minnesota,
for the November 2024 election,
is Tuesday, October 13.**



ID Requirements

In Minnesota, photo ID is not required to register or cast a ballot. If you need to register or update your registration, or you have not voted in four years or more, you will need to show proof of residence before voting.

Absentee Voting

Minnesota does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters may request an absentee ballot until November 3 but the Secretary of State recommends requesting it by mail, online, or in-person by October 20.

Absentee ballots must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

A US citizen who is 18 or older on election day or a notary must witness you complete the absentee ballot.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it by mail, in person to the election office that sent your ballot, or at a drop box.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Minnesota can vote absentee in-person or vote early for any reason. Absentee in-person voting begins on Friday, September 28 and early voting begins on October 16. Both options end on Monday, November 2. You can register to vote and update your voter registration in-person, at your polling place, when voting absentee in-person and when early voting.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Minnesota at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5. Towns with less than 500 residents aren't required to open until 10 am.
