

Get Out the Vote in Nevada



The voter registration deadline in Nevada, for the November 2026 election, is October 6 (by mail) and November 3 (online and in person)



ID Requirements

In Nevada, photo IDs (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) are not required to cast a ballot, except for some first time voters and voters taking advantage of same-day registration.

Absentee Voting

All registered voters will receive their ballot automatically as long as they're registered no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Absentee ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 3 and received by 5 pm on the 4th day after the election.

If you would like to hand deliver your ballot to an official drop-box, vote center, polling location, or the clerk/registrar's office it must be dropped off by 7pm on November 3.

PFLAG recommends that voters get their absentee ballots in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Nevada can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on October 17 and ends on October 30.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Nevada at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
