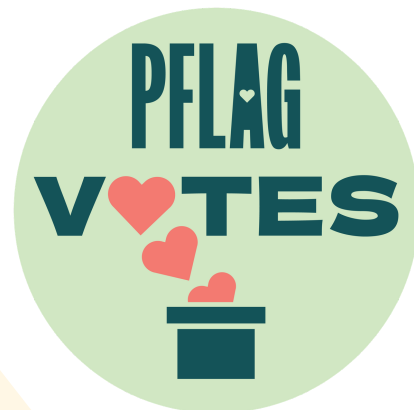




Get Out the Vote in New Hampshire



The voter registration deadline in New Hampshire, for the November 2026 election, depends on the locality. Generally the deadline is 6-13 days before the election.



ID Requirements

In New Hampshire, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID) is required to register and cast a ballot. If you do not have an approved ID, you can obtain a free photo ID by presenting a voucher from your town clerk to any NH DMV. Student IDs cannot be used as proof of identity.

Absentee Voting

Voters in New Hampshire with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by Monday, November 2 by 12pm (by mail) or 5 pm (in-person)

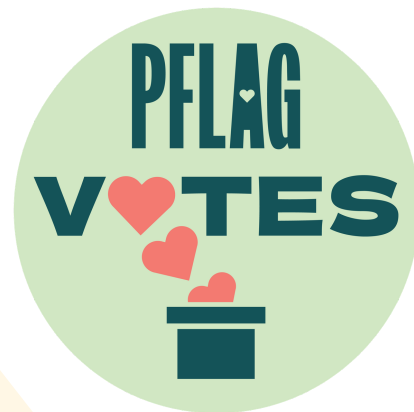
Absentee ballots must be received by 5 pm on Tuesday, November 3 if returning by mail. If returning in person, ballots must be received by 5 pm on Monday, November 2.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

New Hampshire does not offer in-person early voting.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in New Hampshire between at 6 am and 11 am and close no earlier than 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
