

Get Out the Vote in New Jersey



**The voter registration deadline in New Jersey,
for the November 2026 election,
is Tuesday, October 13.**



ID Requirements

In New Jersey, ID is not required to cast a ballot, unless you did not provide identification when registering. When you register, you'll be asked to provide a driver's license number, non-driver ID number, or the last four digits of your social security number.

Vote-by-Mail

New Jersey does not require an excuse to vote by mail.

If you would like to receive your ballot by mail you must request your ballot by October 27. You can also pick up your ballot at your county clerk's office until 3pm on November 2.

Your ballot must be received by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3 if returning in person at a drop box or your county clerk's office.

Your ballot must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 3 and received within six days if you are returning it by mail.

Your ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day or during early voting.

Early Voting

All registered voters in New Jersey can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Saturday, October 24 and ends on Sunday, November 1. •Early voting locations are open 10am-8pm Monday to Saturday and 10am-6pm on Sunday.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in New Jersey at 6 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
