

Get Out the Vote in New Mexico



The voter registration deadline in New Mexico, for the November 2026 election, is Tuesday, October 6.



ID Requirements

In New Mexico, identification is required to register, but not to cast a ballot. A physical ID is only required for first-time voters who registered by mail and did not include identification with their application.

Absentee Voting

New Mexico does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Tuesday, October 20.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

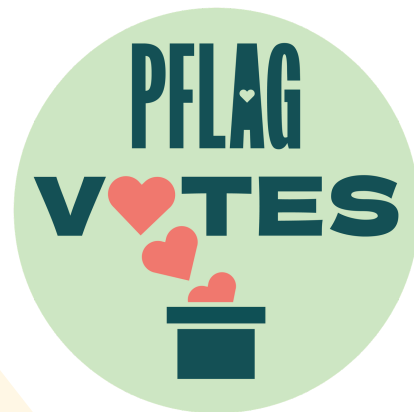
Your absentee ballot can be returned by mail or hand delivered by you or a family member to the office of the county clerk, at an early voting location, or at your polling place on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in New Mexico can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Tuesday, October 6 and ends on Saturday, October 31.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in New Mexico at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
