



Get Out the Vote in South Carolina



The voter registration deadline in South Carolina is October 2 (in-person), October 4 (online), and October 5 (by mail).



ID Requirements

In South Carolina, photo ID (e.g., driver license, military ID, passport) is required to cast a ballot. You can obtain a free photo ID from the DMV. Voters who do not have a photo ID may cast a provisional ballot and provide a photo ID before Thursday, November 7.

Absentee Voting

Voters in South Carolina with a valid excuse may vote absentee.

They must request their ballot by 5 pm on Friday, October 23.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

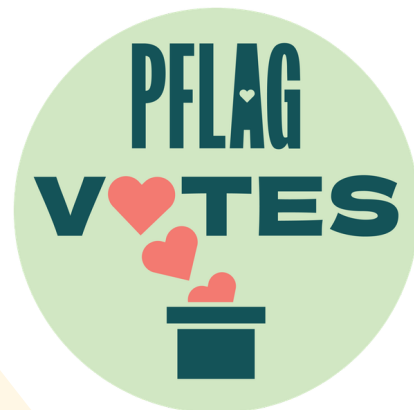
Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in South Carolina can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Monday, October 21 and ends on Saturday, November 2. Early voting centers are open 8:30am-6pm Monday-Saturday. They are not open on Sunday, October 25.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in South Carolina at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
