



Get Out the Vote in the U.S. Virgin Islands



The voter registration deadline in the U.S. Virgin Islands, for the November 2026 election, is Sunday, October 4.



ID Requirements

In the U.S. Virgin Islands, identification is required to register and is requested when casting a ballot. If a voter does not have proper identification, they can complete an affidavit of affirmation that they are the person listed on the poll list before being permitted to vote.

Absentee Voting

The U.S. Virgin Islands do not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Most voters must request their ballot by October 20.

Absentee ballots must be received by 5pm on November 3.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Voting on Election Day

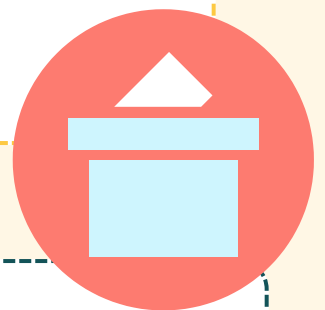
Polls open in the Virgin Islands at 7 am and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
