

Get Out the Vote in Vermont



The voter registration deadline in Vermont, for the November 2026 election, is Tuesday, November 3.



ID Requirements

In Vermont, ID is required to register, but not to cast a ballot. The ID must include your name and address. First-time voters who registered to vote by mail will have to show ID in order to vote.

Absentee Voting

Vermont automatically mails ballots to all registered voters.

Voters may request an absentee ballot if they need their ballot mailed to a temporary mailing address. These requests must be submitted by 5pm on November 2

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

Your absentee ballot can be hand delivered to your polling place on election day.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Vermont can vote early for any reason. You can vote early by completing your mail ballot at your town clerk's office beginning Saturday, September 19 and ending Monday, November 2.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Vermont between 5am and 10am and close at 7pm on Tuesday, November 3.
