

Get Out the Vote in Washington



The voter registration deadline in Washington, for the November 2026 election, is Monday, October 26.



ID Requirements

In Washington, photo ID is requested to register and cast a ballot in person. If you do not have a photo ID, you can sign a declaration stating you are the person listed on the poll list.

Absentee Voting

All registered Washington voters will be automatically mailed an absentee ballot.

Absentee ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 3.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail or a drop box.

PFLAG recommends that voters get their ballots in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Washington can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins on Friday, October 16 and ends on Monday, November 2.

Voting on Election Day

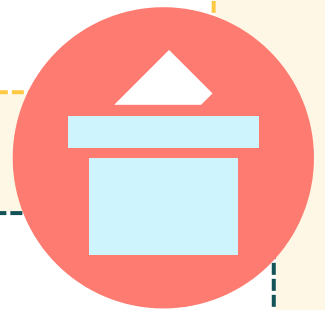
Polls open in Washington at varying times depending on the county and close at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.
