

Get Out the Vote in Wyoming



The voter registration deadline in Wyoming, for the November 2026 election, is October 19 (by mail) and November 3 (in person).



ID Requirements

In Wyoming, photo IDs are required to cast a ballot in person. If you do not have an acceptable photo ID, you can get a free WY identification card from your local Driver Services office.

Absentee Voting

Wyoming does not require an excuse for absentee voting.

Voters must request their ballot by Monday, November 2.

Absentee ballots must be received by 7 pm on Tuesday, November 3.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered on election day to your polling place. You must return it via mail or hand deliver to your county clerk's office.

PFLAG recommends that voters request their absentee ballots as soon as possible and get them in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 20.

Early Voting

All registered voters in Wyoming can vote early. Early voting begins on October 6 and ends on November 2.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Wyoming at 7am and close at 7pm on Tuesday, November 3.

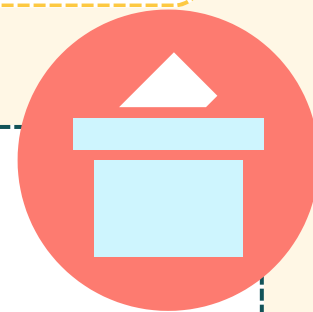
You can register to vote in person at your polling place on election day.
